Shining Hospital Surkhet (SHS) and Fistula Center

Since the beginning of its establishment, Shining hospital Surkhet has been serving people affected by leprosy through proper diagnosis and treatment. It has been providing treatment, follow-up, referral, food, accommodation, counselling, prosthesis, and orthotics services to the leprosy patients which are free of cost.



Shining Hospital INF Banke (SHIB)

Shining Hospital INF Banke (SHIB) is providing medical care, counselling, education, awareness, outreach and advocacy for people affected by leprosy, leprosy with tuberculosis, and Lymphatic Filariasis (LF). The hospital provides outpatient services and 24 beds for inpatient services.

SHIB is committed to lessening the burden of leprosy and reducing leprosy transmissions by timely and complete treatments including self-care, care-after-cure, stigma reduction, and early case findings.

SHIB is offering leprosy and dermatology services to patients visiting from Banke, Bardiya, nearby districts and Indian people who live close to the border.

Projects

Green Pastures Hospital

Green Pastures Hospital (GPH), Pokhara is a 100-bedded multi-disciplinary hospital and rehabilitation centre caring for persons with disability, the only such centre in Western Nepal.

It has specialist services in dermatology and leprosy, hearing disabilities, orthopaedic and spinal surgery, spinal cord injury (SCI) and spinal disorders, plastic and reconstructive surgery, palliative care and chronic disease, and rehabilitation.

A dedicated multi-disciplinary team consisting of medical, nursing, paramedical, allied health professionals, and administration work as a cohesive team to provide holistic care to address the physical, psychological, social, and spiritual needs of the patients.



The mission of GPH is to transform lives by offering holistic rehabilitation services, fostering independence, and promoting overall well-being. Our vision is to be a centre of excellence in rehabilitation, recognized for our patient-centric approach, advanced medical practices, and impactful community outreach.

Empowering Women and Girls through WASH and Livelihood

Kalikot is one of the most remote districts in Nepal and faces multiple developmental challenges including poverty, domestic violence, disasters and lack of access to water and sanitation. This project, run by our partner International Nepal Fellowship Nepal, aims to empower women and girls through Self Help Groups (SHG).

In 2023-24, the project will deliver:

- Vocational Training for women to start micro-enterprises (tailoring, animal rearing etc)
- Training of secondary school teachers/school nurses to provide education on Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights (SRHR), Gender Equality (GE), Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) and Child Marriage.
- Support for local government as they educate and produce curriculum on these issues
